

## Job fair set for Thursday

If you're looking for a new job, polish up your resume, shoes and interview skills because employers will be on hand at a Yuba City job fair.

Twenty-four companies will be on hand Thursday for the second annual Yuba-Sutter Youth Job Fair at the Yuba Sutter Mall.

"This is a youth job fair, but it's open to anyone," said Jennie Archuleta, a business workforce specialist with Sutter County One Stop.

Sutter County One Stop and Yuba County One Stop are co-sponsoring the afternoon event.

"Since they'll have a short time to meet with employers, we recommend that people dress professionally and bring lots of copies of their resume," said Archuleta.

Archuleta recommends women wear a shirt with a collar and slacks or a skirt. She recommends men wear dress slacks, a button-up shirt and, if the prospective job requires, a jacket and tie.

"Be ready to give a 30-60 second introduction speech where people talk about who they are and what skills or abilities they have," said Archuleta.

"Also, be ready to talk about what jobs you want or target for what jobs the employer has available," said Archuleta. "People looking for a job should relate how they're skills are relevant to the employer."

She said to be prepared for an on-the-spot interview, but don't expect one, and when interacting with a prospective employer, smile, make eye contact and shake hands.

"When talking to employers, speak with them like an adult and don't use slang," said Archuleta.

"If they don't find a job at the fair, there are recourses available and people can come to the One Stop in Sutter County or Yuba County," said Archuleta.
